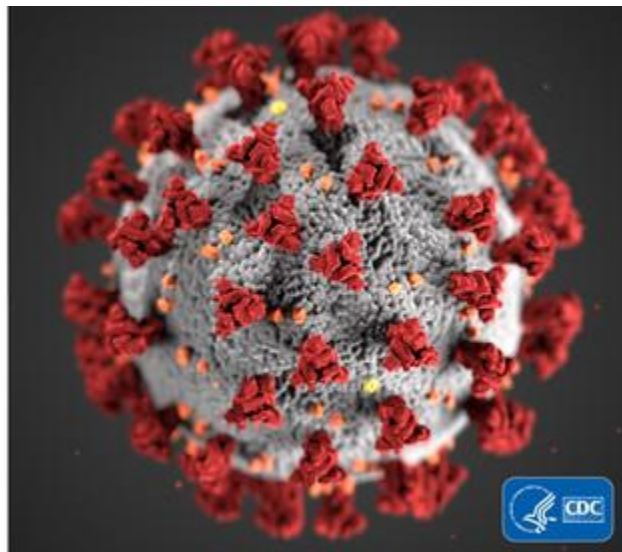
Upcoming Webinars on SBA Loan Products for Small Businesses Impacted by COVID-19

The SBA Wichita District Office and Kansas Small Business Development Center will present the latest information on resources available for small businesses and non-profits affected by COVID-19.

Currently, the SBA offers Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDL) for small business, small agricultural cooperatives and most private, non-profit organizations across Kansas.

The SBA can provide up to \$2 million in EIDL funds to help meet financial obligations and operating expenses that could have been met had the disaster not occurred.

Interest rates for EIDL are 3.75% for small business, 2.75% for non-profits. Loans are for 30 years with 12 months deferred payments.
